## **Certificate I in Transition Education**

This course is designed to support learners with permanent intellectual disabilities



The focus of this course is to support learners with permanent intellectual disabilities to develop the skills to find the most appropriate option for them in the community. This may include employment, volunteer work or further study.

The course will develop valuable learning and social skills by exploring:

- independent living
- personal development
- vocational and employability skills
- community involvement
- volunteering effectively
- basic literacy and numeracy
- use of everyday technology.

### **DELIVERY METHOD**

Delivery of this course is via face-to-face classes and will be supported by our Learning Management System.

All equipment and resources are provided for learners enrolling in this course.

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

This Certificate is restricted to post-compulsory school aged learners with evidence of a permanent cognitive impairment / intellectual disability. There are no course pre-requisites as this course is at foundation level.

Learners will be required to undertake a Pre-Training Review and Language, Literacy and Numeracy assessment. This will identify any competencies previously acquired through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), or Credit Transfer, ascertain that the proposed learning strategies and materials are appropriate for each student and to ascertain current learning, reading writing, oral communication and numeracy skills. The pre-training review will determine if this course is suitable for you.



This training is delivered to eligible individuals with Victorian and Commonwealth Government funding.

To be eligible for government funding an individual must meet specific Skills First requirements. Please refer to the Cobram Community House Pre-enrolment information sheet for more details.
