Certificate I in Initial Adult Literacy and Numeracy



Certificate I in Initial Adult Literacy and Numeracy is designed to develop the literacy, numeracy skills and communication skills of learners with an intellectual disability.

Participants will learn to write simple sentences, communicate through conversation and develop basic numeracy skills using money, time, and measurement through hands-on activities. Your self-esteem and confidence will grow as your interpersonal skills improve.

This course is a great option for adult learners to develop the skills required for independence and further study.

WHAT WILL YOU STUDY?

Literacy - reading, writing and communicating phrases and sentences, and completing forms.

Numeracy - counting and using numbers to 100, basic mathematical operations, giving and following directions, measurement, using coins and notes.



DELIVERY METHOD

Delivery of this course is via face-to-face classes at Cobram Community House.

Class times

Tuesdays 9.00am-3.00pm during Victorian school terms.

All equipment and resources are provided for learners enrolling in this course.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entry to the 22694VIC Certificate I in Initial Adult literacy and Numeracy is restricted to post compulsory school age learners with evidence of a permanent cognitive impairment / intellectual disability.

Learners must be able to show evidence of a diagnosed intellectual disability or specific learning difficulties requiring additional support.

Evidence could include:

- Formal assessment by a registered medical practitioner
- Doctors / specialist reports
- Attendance at a Special School / SDS
- Integration support at school

Learners will be required to undertake a Pre-Training Review and Language, Literacy and Numeracy assessment.

To be eligible for the award of the 22694VIC Certificate I in Initial Adult Literacy and Numeracy learners must successfully complete a total of 11 units:
